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CRAFT

MATERIALS NEEDED

empty juice box
craft paper
tape/glue
scissors

- While the kids drink their juice boxes cut out 2 different sized triangles from the craft paper.
- Have them color or decorate triangles with stickers.
- Tape or glue the triangles together and connect to the straw
- Poke a hole in the center of the empty juice box and insert straw. Tape over the hole so water doesn't get in.
